How Much Does It Cost To Participate?

There is no cost.

The VA has awarded Tampa Crossroads funding to provide SSVF services FREE to qualified veterans. All households receive at minimum case management & linkages to VA & public benefits.

ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Applicants must meet the following minimum criteria to be eligible for SSVF:

- . Head of household or spouse of head of household must be a veteran.*
- 2. Household annual income cannot exceed 50% of AMI (see chart below).
- 3. Household must be homeless or at imminent risk of becoming homeless.
- 4. Household must have no other resources available to access or maintain permanent housing stability.

*Veteran is defined as a person who served in any branch of the United States military who was discharged or released under conditions other than dishonorable.
